HERITAGE/COMMUNITY EVENT

Three years ago our local Rotary Club, along with three other Rotary Clubs and supported by the National Australia Day Council held an event at Sea Breeze Reserve on the Kincumber Broadwater. Now for a third year we are again leading the four Rotary Clubs of Kincumber, Erina, Terrigal and Kariong/Somersby to hold an 'Historic' Australia Day event, this time at Terrigal Haven.

The Haven was chosen because in the latter half of the 1800s it was the site of a timber mill and shipyard owned by one of the four shipbuilding Davis brothers. The brothers were orphaned at an early age and taken under the wing of Johnathan Piper, known as the father of Brisbane Water shipbuilding, the shipyard was at today's Yattalunga. All four brothers eventually established their own shipyards on Cockle Creek Channel at a place that became known as Davistown.

In 1869 Thomas Davis moved his operations to Terrigal Haven, he dammed a small creek and created a lagoon in the area which is now the sports oval. From this he drew the fresh water needed for the boiler of a steam engine, which powered the timber mill. He began logging the area, timber from north Avoca and also Avoca which he floated across Avoca Lagoon, it then was brought up the steep hill via a tramway he built. The route of this tramway is today marked by a road joining Scenic Highway called Tramway Road.


A stone slipway was built into the waters of the Haven upon which twenty one ships were built over a twenty three year

period. The most famous of these ships, infact one of the most significant Australian ships in our history, the 'General Gordon', known as "The vessel that linked the Nation" when it filled the gap in 2,700kms of Inter-Capital City railway while Hawkesbury Bridge was built. In 2024 an 'Historic' Australia Day event will be held at Terrigal Haven. There will be a *History Display* telling:

- The story of Thomas Davis and his Ship Building. There will be models of:
 - A steam operated saw mill
 - The vessel General Gordon
 - Working General Gordon's engines
 - Other models, dioramas and information

Commencing with a:

- Welcome To Country and a Smoking Ceremony Then a:



- **Bottled Water**
- Other Aussie treats, like Lamingtons

There is also:

- An entertaining M/C and Magician
- Live Music

Why not park in the Free Terrigal Multi-Story Car Park and take the short but wonderful cliff face boardwalk to 'The Haven'.

Thanks to Rotary, National Australia Day Council and other partners for presenting some amazing 3 Village heritage at Terrigal Haven on Australia Day.
