

MURAL & PLANTING PROJECT

The road works on Davistown Rd have been long since completed, however, we have been left with a rather blank, exposed space. The 3VCG see this as a wonderful opportunity to add some colour and make it a wonderful welcome to the 3 villages.

The wall is planned to have a mural inspired by the words suggested by the community earlier this year. We have contacted the artists nominated by the community and interested artists are currently creating a brief of ideas for the space, these artists will then be narrowed down and a mural created for the space. Our plans will then continue onto the garden above. We are planning a garden full of native pollinators. Lots of colour, a garden with a wonderful selection of plants that will really bring the space to life. We will be holding a community planting day in November. FROM THE BIRD TURD BAR

In 1790, the beautiful Italian city of Turin was the scene of a duel involving young French aristocrat Xavier de Maistre who was subsequently arrested and punished by spending 6 weeks in his room. To pass the time, young Xavier wrote his famous "Voyage Around My Room" (now an amusing and insightful philosophy text) in which he described his *discoveries* as he explored his familiar space in a manner which Proust would describe as "having new eyes".

When thinking about "Bells and Whistles" for this issue, I was struck by the idea of seeing our familiar places with those "new eyes". Mt. Pleasant, Saratoga came to mind.

(If anyone knows what the Aboriginal people called it, I'd like to know)

I have trekked many wild places of the world, seen beautiful waterways from all corners of the globe, but I've not seen any waterway any more picturesque than Brisbane Water furtively displayed below the mount.

A brisk walk past sentinels of burrawangs and

grass-trees, epiphytebejewelled boulders, under turpentines towering over moss-covered, fallen elders brings one to a beckoning gap between lichen-covered turrets to the rock platforms of the "summit" where one is more than rewarded for any shortness of breath by the encircling green and blue tapestry which. while not breathtaking, like any precious jewel, rewards one for spending a little time and leaving the beaten track.

Subtle vistas of water and bush may be seen at all points of the compass, North to Point Frederick, West to Woy Woy Bay, South to Umina, East across the Broadwater and on to the Tasman Sea. Sunset alights the scene in a way which is not surpassed by any other view on the planet.

MEET THE LOCALS


SAM WORKMAN



LOCAL COMMUNITY ORGANISATION

It's probably a good time to highlight the work of our local Rotary Club, Rotary Kincumber, as it is celebrating 40 years woking for our community and is now based at Davistown RSL Club. F to F Meetings are held every other Monday, the alternative week is a Zoom meeting. This Rotary Club's area of operations takes

in most of Eastern Brisbane Water and includes Avoca Beach, Bensville, Copacabana, Daleys

Point, Empire Bay, Green Point, Hardys Bay, Killcare, Kincumber, Macmasters Beach, Pretty Beach, Wagstaffe as well as our 3 Villages of Yattalunga, Saratoga, Davistown where they have been particularly active.

Over the years the Club has worked within the community on a wide range of projects, for example in 1986 it was involved with the celebrations to open the Mooney Bridge. In 2011 it planned a big presence at the scuttling of ex-HMAS Adelaide, however, actions raising fears of everything from the paint peeling off the ship, to it changing tidal flow and washing Avoca Beach away, caused a last minute delay in the sinking, this left the Club with hundreds of 'T' Shirts it had printed with the incorrect date.

The Christmas raffle was always popular with a trailer full of goodies on show each December, this raised tens of thousands of dollars for the Club's community projects and was so synonymous with Christmas locally. When the Club lost access to the storage facility to house this trailer and its treasure, the raffle gradually wound down.

With the publication of Gwen Dundon's book Shipbuilders of Brisbane Water came a realisation of the incredible maritime history of Kincumber and the Three Villages and so Rotary began to develop the idea of creating a Shipbuilders Memorial along the new pedestrian/cycle path linking the areas. Brisbane Water resident and former shipwright turned world regarded sculptor, designed and constructed the main sculpture at the head of the walk, as well as the sandstone and stainless steel plinths placed at the site of each of the old shipyards. So far seven plinths have been installed with at more planned, the next Plinth will be in recognition of the people who lived on the waterways for tens of thousands of years before European arrival.

Some years ago Rotary initiated a fun run called the Kincumber Mountain Challenge, this soon became a far less strenuous event called the 4 Villages Walk. Further development of the event saw it adopt a distinct 'heritage' identity becoming the 4 Villages-Shipbuilders Heritage Walk.



Year 11 Business Studies Entrepreneur Exhibition


